



Commercial tanker conversion to HMAS Sirius (2006)

Tenix Defence delivered HMAS Sirius to the Royal Australian Navy, following an extensive conversion project undertaken at the Common User Facility (CUF).

The project saw the former commercial tanker, Delos, undergo seven major modification packages over a one year period.

The modifications, many of which were the first of their kind in Australia, utilised a range of infrastructure provided at the CUF including the High-Wide Load Transit Corridor and the Southern Services Wharf prior to the sail away of the vessel in September 2006.

HMAS Sirius replaces HMAS Westralia as a Naval Oil Replenishment Ship.

The \$60 million conversion meets global environmental requirements and will enable the RAN surface fleet to be refuelled worldwide.
