



# Fraser Diving: Submarine launch and recovery exercises (2004)

Fraser Diving used the Common User Facility's (CUF) southern services wharf and loadout area for a launch and recovery training exercise in April 2004.

The CUF's 13 metre water depth was ideal for the exercise in which a dummy escape hatch was placed on the seabed and a ROV was 'flown' into position for connection to the hatch.

In real situations, personnel could then be transferred from a submarine to the rescue chamber
