



Monadelphous: Fit-out of wharf modules for Rio Tinto

The wharf modules have been sent to the CUF for Rio Tinto's Cape Lambert iron ore venture for final fit out.

Monadelphous, one of Australia's leading engineering groups will be utilising the CUF's laydown area to fit out the modules which will be shipped to the Pilbara later this year. Works will include the installation of concrete deck panel, power and control cabling, walkways, handrails and conveyors.

A Big Lift ship will be used to transport the modules directly from the assembly site at the AMC to the North West.

Berthing dolphins are being stored at the CUF until piling work is completed at Cape Lambert and will be shipped with the modules in late 2008, once again demonstrating the advantages offered by the CUF for project delivery, from start to finish.
