



Alinta: Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline

More than 4000 pieces of 16metre steel pipe was offloaded at the AMC-CUF for Stage Five of the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline.

Owned by Dampier Bunbury Pipeline, which is made up of a number of companies including leading Australian energy infrastructure provider Alinta, the pipeline is one of the longest and largest capacity natural gas lines in Australia.

Each piece, made from mild steel with a resistant plastic coating, will be used to increase the capacity of the 1600kilometre pipeline, which stretches from Western Australia's North-West gas field down to the State's South-West.

The Stage Five expansion will increase capacity of the system which represents a crucial link in the State's energy distribution supplying gas to industrial, commercial and residential customers in Perth and major regional centres.
