



## Van Gogh and Pluto Projects

More than 4000 pieces of 16metre steel pipe was offloaded at the AMC-CUF for Stage Five of the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline.

In February 2008 piping manifolds and other subsea equipment were shipped to the AMC-CUF in preparation for subsea activities related to Apache's Van Gogh project and Woodside's Pluto Liquefied Natural Gas Project.

The AMC-CUF provided essential staging capacity in the lay-down area for both projects, which are located offshore on the North-West Shelf, to assemble systems that will be installed on the sea bed as part of the subsea well infrastructure.

The subsea equipment for the Pluto Project will provide vital conduits to process gas from the Pluto and Xena gas fields while Apache's Van Gogh Project will install subsea well infrastructure to feed oil to a Floating Production and Storage Offtake vessel.
