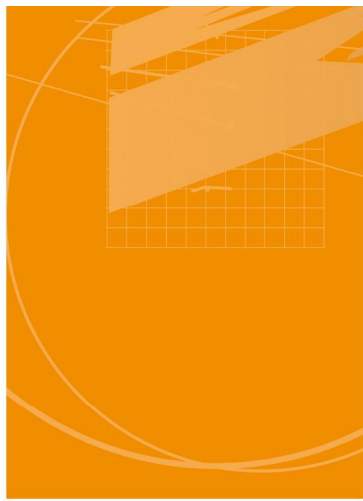

AGC: Fabrication of biodiesel refinery (2006)

Western Australian engineering firm AGC used the Common User Facility's (CUF) Fabrication Hall to construct an \$11 million mobile biodiesel plant for Natural Fuel Australia's \$45 million biodiesel facility in Darwin.

The 420 tonne module was shipped from the CUF to Darwin in mid July 2006 on the MV Wiebka.

The plant will manufacture approximately 105,000 tonnes of biodiesel a year - a fuel derived from natural vegetable oil which can be used to replace fossil diesel fuel.
