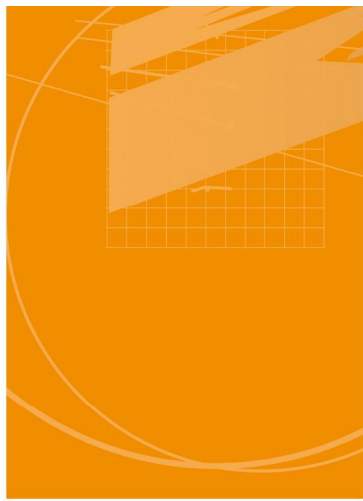

AGC: Fabrication of process tanks for transportation

AGC are in the process of completing the civil, mechanical, electrical design, supply and fabrication of five process tanks fully completed on transport grillages to be shipped by barge to the Blacktip Project Onshore Gas Plant.

Measuring more than 18 metres in diameter, 20 metres high and 220 tonnes each, these are the largest tanks to be built for transportation in Australia.

Designed with the use of a synchronised jacking system, no craneage is required for the onsite positioning of the tanks onto the concrete ring beams.

Previously, tanks of this scale needed to be built onsite, however flexible world class infrastructure enabled the work to be completed and shipped from the CUF to the Timor Sea.
