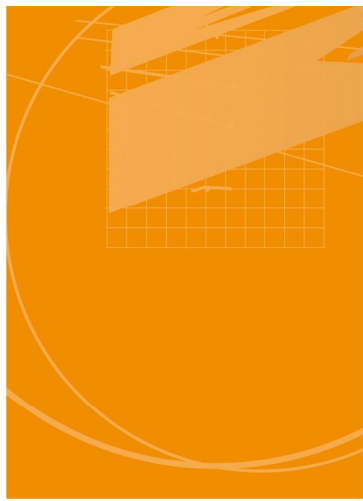

ThyssenKrupp: Ore stacker assembly

The AMC-CUF provided vital infrastructure for ThyssenKrupp Engineering Australia to assemble an ore stacker for BHP Billiton's Rapid Growth Project 4.

Fabricated in workshops around Perth, components of the stacker were transported to the CUF for assembly into a complete unit prior to being commissioned and prepared for transport.

The unit, which will deposit bulk ore into stockpiles for blending and loading, was transferred onto an 85 metre by 23 metre barge at the CUF's loadout wharf in April 08 for the journey to Port Hedland.

"Modular construction is a more effective way of supplying equipment for major projects and the AMC Common User Facility provides us with access to the space and infrastructure we need in order to complete these major elements of the project," **Andrew Paton, Project Manager ThyssenKrupp**
