Modular Engineering has a growing reputation across the booming resources sector for the supply and local manufacture of internationally recognised products from their ISO 9001 accredited workshop facility in the Common User Facility support precinct.

The company is a privately owned steel fabrication specialist which locally manufactures AS1210 pressure vessels, filters, separators, coalescers, scrubbers, produced water treatment systems, deoiling and desanding hydrocyclones, process tanks, pipe spooling, pipe supports, structures, base-plates and where required the assembly of these individual components into modular or skid-mounted equipment packages complete with electrical control systems, valves and instrumentation.

Modular Engineering started operations from their Sparks Road workshop at the Australian Marine Complex (AMC) in 2000 and currently employs 18 multiskilled trades and apprentices, the majority of whom have been with the company since its inception.

With more than 30-years experience between them, Modular Engineering's co-directors, John Davies and Hugh Hughes, are committed to providing their clients with a high standard of quality products and service.

"Our philosophy at Modular is to be the benchmark in our industry for quality, reliability, customer service and, very important in this climate, employee satisfaction and retention," Mr Davies said.

"We strongly believe in developing mutually beneficial working relationships that foster repeat business opportunities for the company and by constantly meeting or bettering our customers, suppliers and employees expectations we ensure this happens."

Modular Engineering saw unprecedented growth just six months into their establishment, due to a major agency agreement and fabrication contract with PECO USA – manufacturing filtration and separation vessels for the Woodside LNG 4 project – and have since repeated the supply of PECO equipment to Woodside's LNG1, 2, 3, LNG5, Angel and Pluto projects.

The company currently has a growing forward order book and long-term contracts with local and international companies with equipment destined for locations across Australia, Europe, Asia and the Middle East.

"I can honestly say that Modular Engineering have been involved, in some way, with many of the major resource and infrastructure projects that have taken place in WA and the NT over the past 7-year period," Mr Davies said.

Modular Engineering has manufacturing licences and/or agency agreements with Perry Equipment Corporation USA (PECO) and eProcess Technology in Melbourne, which has enhanced the company's capabilities and capacity to be involved in the supply of some very interesting capital equipment contracts across a broad cross section of industries. ■
